

If I've tested positive for COVID-19, do I still need the vaccine?

Yes, but if you were recently infected with COVID-19, you should wait until you are fully recovered to get vaccinated. Additionally, if you were treated for COVID-19 with monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma, you should wait 90 days before getting the COVID-19 vaccine. Talk to your doctor if you are unsure about what treatments you received.
