What Can You Do Today to Prevent a Fall?

Protect yourself and your crew by following these tips.

Cover holes with at least 3/4 inch plywood, oriented strand board or other cover that supports Always use fall protection at least twice the weight of workers and materials, and secure the wood with nails or screws equipment when working on roofs higher than 6 feet off the Make sure the top of the ladder ground extends at least 3 feet above the surface you are climbing to, and the side rails extend at least 1 foot Use an access ladder to above the top rung climb onto the scaffold Always tie off the ladder Position the ladder at a 4 to 1 angle* Use a screw jack to Make sure there stabilize the scaffolding are guardrails framework
