
MICROSOFT POWER POINT HYPERLINK REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS

The Foundations for Safety Leadership (FSL) power point (PPT) slides have **hyperlinked** buttons that when clicked on take you to a specific slide within the PPT file. Sometimes these links "break". You can fix a broken hyperlink by using these instructions.



FIXING HYPERLINKS:

1. IN NORMAL VIEW, MAKE SURE THAT THE BROKEN BUTTON IS SELECTED.



2. On the Insert tab, click Hyperlink.




3. Click Place in This Document, click the slide that you want to use as the hyperlink destination, then click OK.




MAC 2011 VERSION

FIXING HYPERLINKS:

1. Make sure that the broken button is selected.



2. On the **Home** tab, under insert, click **Text**, and then click **Hyperlink**.



3. In the **Documents** tab, and then under **Anchor**, click **Locate**. Then select the slide that the button should be linked to. Click **OK** twice.
